How to find a rental unit

**FOR
RENT**



Where to look:

1. **Facebook Marketplace**
2. **Zillow rentals**
3. **Apartments.com - \$29.00 fee good for 1 month for any apartment application.**
4. Classified section of the local newspaper
5. Bulletin boards in laundromats, grocery stores, banks, etc.
6. Family and friends - they may know places that are or might become available
7. If there is a specific area you are interested in living, drive or walk around that area. You may spot "FOR RENT" signs in yards, on trees, in windows.
8. Contact the apartment listings in our rental guide
9. Check with real estate agents and landlords. Check the web for "Real Estate Rental Service" or "Real Estate Management"

Things to think about:

- ✓ What type of unit am I looking at? Single family home, mobile home, apartment, duplex, etc.?
- ✓ What area is the unit located in? Is it within the city limits? What county?
- ✓ You may want to check with the utility companies to determine if there are deposits that are required.
- ✓ Check with the landlord regarding any special restriction on the unit such as no smoking, no pets, etc.
- ✓ Find out what utilities you will have to pay (heat, electric, water, waste removal)
- ✓ Do a budget plan to assess whether the rental is affordable.

Making an appointment:

Once you have found a rental unit and it is what you are looking for, ask the owner for an appointment to see the unit. **BE SURE TO KEEP THE APPOINTMENT AND BE ON TIME.** You may want to arrive early so that you can look around the neighborhood and get a feel for the community. Remember, meeting with the landlord is like a job interview, dress well, be pleasant and be honest.

Questions you should ask a prospective landlord

1. The address and phone number of the apartment/home you are interested in renting.
2. The name, address, and telephone number of the property owner or his/her agent.
3. The number of bedrooms and bathrooms in the home.
4. The amount of rent the landlord is asking.
5. The amount of security deposit required.
6. Will you accept Section 8/Housing Choice Vouchers?
7. Would you consider discounted rent if I signed on for a longer lease?
8. What happens if I need to break the lease early?
9. Am I able to pay rent online?
10. Will you have the unit cleaned before I move in?
11. Is there a policy to customize the unit with paint, wall hangings, etc.
12. What is your policy when it comes to overnight guests?
13. How much notice will you give before entering the unit?
14. Who takes care of maintenance?
15. Will I be able to have emergency issues taken care of promptly?
16. Are there any non-refundable fees I should be aware of?
17. What is your late fee policy?
18. Do you require renters' insurance? If so, which level of coverage?
19. Do you allow pets? If so, what is your pet fee structure?
20. Is A/C included?
21. What is the type of utility service installed for the home?
22. Are any utilities included in the rent?

23. If utilities are not included in the rent, ask the following questions:

- a. What heats the home? Natural gas, propane, electric, fuel oil?

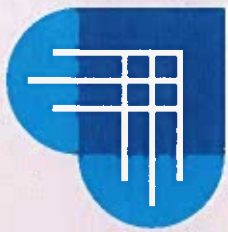

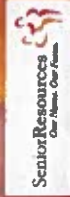
